**NOTIFICATION** 

No. 634-PAR (AR)/O/2R-4/12

Kolkata, the 20th June, 2014.

In exercise of the power conferred by the Bengal Districts Act, 1836 (21 of 1836), read with the Bengal Districts Act, 1864 (Ben. Act IV of 1864) and sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), and in cancellation of all previous notifications relating to the area included in the area in the district of Jalpaiguri and the boundaries thereof, the Governor is pleased to hereby to create, with effect from the 25th day of June, 2014, two districts named as Jalpaiguri and Alipurduar by dividing the existing district of Jalpaiguri, the former with headquarters at Jalpaiguri and the latter with headquarters at Alipurduar respectively.

The Governor is further pleased to direct that with effect from the aforesaid date, the limits of the district of Jalpaiguri shall include the local areas comprised in the sub-divisions and the police stations comprised in each such sub-division as shown in Schedule 'A' and the limit of the district of Alipurduar shall include the local areas comprised in the sub-divisions and the police stations comprised in each sub-division as shown in Schedule 'B'.
